



AFTERCARE GUIDE

CLING FILM



If you have got cling film on your new tattoo, you must do the following when you get home. Keep the film on for 3-4 hours. When you peel off the film, we recommend doing it in the bath, as the tattoo must then be washed with cold to lukewarm water, possibly with a perfume-free soap.

When the tattoo needs to be dried, it is important that you do not wipe it with a towel or anything as it is an open wound. Instead, you must let it air dry for about 15 minutes.

When the tattoo is dry, moisturise it with a cream that is made for tattoos.

We recommend TRUE TATTOO's Tattoo Cream to ensure your new tattoo heals in the best way.

All this takes place at the beginning of life with a new tattoo, after that it is important to take good care of it. You must therefore moisturise it regularly with cream, as it is important that it does not dry out. When you apply the cream, it is important that it is a thin layer, as the skin must be able to breathe through.

Continue applying cream to the tattoo for 3-4 weeks.

Things you must not expose your new tattoo to in the first 4-6 weeks:

Sun, salt water, chlorine water, too hot baths, bathtubs, creams other than tattoo cream, sun cream, hair and other bacteria from animals, soaps with perfume and also perfume in general.
