

AFTERCARE GUIDE DERMALIZE



If you have Dermalize on your new tattoo, you must leave it on for 3-4 days.

Dermalize acts as a protective layer during the first healing phase of your tattoo. When the 3-4 days have passed, CAREFULLY take it off during a bath, as the water dissolves the glue, after which the tattoo is washed with cold to lukewarm water, possibly with a perfume-free soap.

When the tattoo needs to be dried, it is important that you do not wipe it with a towel or anything as it is an open wound. Instead, you must let it air dry for about 15 minutes.

When the tattoo is dry, moistorise it with a cream that is calculated for tattoos. We recommend TRUE TATTOO's Tattoo Cream to ensure your new tattoo heals in the best way.

In the event that your Dermalize comes off prematurely, do the following:

If the loosened area does not affect the tattoo, i.e. there is no review here, the loose Dermalize must be cut off and you continue the progress above.

If the loosened area affects the tattoo, it is then possible for bacteria to get to the tattoo. The remaining Dermalize must therefore be peeled off, so the tattoo can be washed and lubricated as described above.

All this takes place at the beginning of life with a new tattoo, after that it is important to take good care of it. You must therefore lubricate it regularly with cream, as it is important that it does not dry out. When you apply cream, it is important that it is a thin layer, as the skin must be able to breathe through.

Continue applying cream to the tattoo for 3-4 weeks.

Things you must not expose your new tattoo to in the first 4-6 weeks:
Sun, salt water, chlorine water, too hot baths, bathtubs, creams other than tattoo cream, sun cream, hair and other bacteria from animals, soaps with perfume and also perfume in general.
